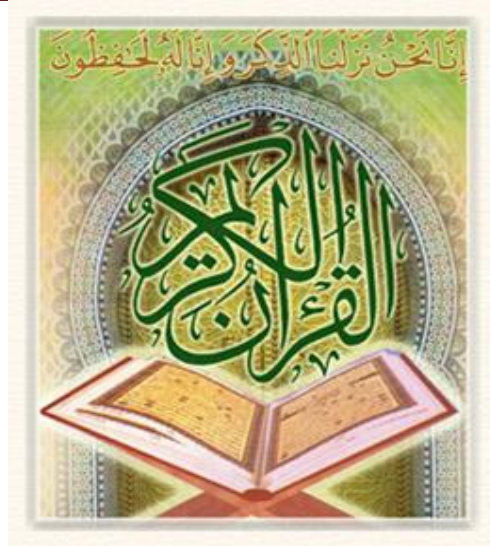

HIFZ SYLLABUS

Indeed, the Noble Quran is the Book of Allah which is a seal of all the scriptures...it is the course for a complete life that ensures prosperity and happiness for the servant in this life and in the Hereafter.

It is the Word of Allah which guides people away from the darkness of *Shirk* and *kufraan* (disbelief) into the lights of Tawheed and Imaan- and for this reason Allah 'azzawajall' has said about this great Book,

“...(This is) a Book which we have revealed unto you in order that you might lead mankind out of darkness into light by their Lord’s Leave to the Path of the All-Mighty, the Owner of all Praise”.
(Ibrahim:1)

HIFZ SYLLABUS

Memorizing the Qur'aan is an act of worship through which one seeks the reward of Allah in this world and in the Hereafter.

It was narrated from 'A'ishah that the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said: **"The one who recites the Qur'aan , will be with the noble righteous scribes (in Heaven) and the one who exerts himself to learn the Qur'aan and recites it with great difficulty, will have a double reward."**

(Narrated by al-Bukhaari, 4653; Muslim, 798)

Madrasah Salafiyah offers and facilitates a program which is **custom made** ensuring that each child receives and benefits from highly qualified teachers the art of memorizing the Holy Quran. The course covers all the aspects of Hifz from elementary classes focusing on Tajweed and correct letter pronunciation through to memorization and completion of the Holy Quran.

The duration of the course is 5 years and is designed and structured to maximize the learning ability of each child, also ensuring your child's school education is not compromised. **Each year there is a target and an annual exam which the pupil must pass before they can commence on to the next stage.**

It has been scientifically proven that the long term memory cells can retain memory for as long as decades if the information absorbed is done in a thorough consistent manner.

The Hifz syllabus is carefully constructed to do just that and below is a table representing how all this takes place within a 5 year program.

The table above goes through the amount of Quran learnt by each child for his/her respective year. This table will give you an indication of the commitment and effort needed by both the student undertaking the Hifz course and the Parents, as well as the teacher who is teaching the child.

The end result is that after 5 years Insha-allah the pupil will have succeeded in completing the Hifz course and become a qualified hafiz of the Holy Quran, mastering the correct Tajweed rules which are applied to the Holy Quran. If a child is naturally gifted and makes the effort of learning his lines consistently, surpassing the amount of lines/Juz that need to be covered in his year, ie (if child has completed 3 Juz in 10 months and passed the annual exam), then the Madrasah will move the child on to the next stage of the syllabus, which will result in the child completing the Hifz course in 4-5 years Insha-allah.

HIFZ SYLLABUS

Pre-Hifz Class

Parents are advised that the child who wishes to enroll on to the Hifz course MUST have a basic grasp of being able to read the Quran fluently.

Any child who is not able to read the Quran fluently must therefore enroll on to the pre-Hifz Class, which educates a child through the elementary stages of the syllabus which includes Nazira, (reading the Quran), Basic Tajweed rules, Dua's, Fiqh and Prayer.

The pre-Hifz class has been carefully constructed accommodating different types of learners who are not familiar with reciting the Quran fluently. Using valuable study resources and expertise teaching, pupils will be able to gain a good understanding of reading the Holy Quran fluently and subsequently will be moved on to the 1st year of the Hifz course. There is no time limit set in the Pre Hifz class, with the emphasis being placed on the individuals learning ability only.

If the child is able to learn the method of reading the Holy Quran correctly based on the education received by the tutor in a few months, then the child will as a result be moved on to the 1st year of the Hifz Course.

However, on the contrary, if the child is not making sufficient progress, they must continue their studies in the pre-Hifz class until they are deemed competent enough to progress further.

***The cost of the pre-Hifz class will be £20 per month and will run for 2 hours daily. (Mon-Fri)**

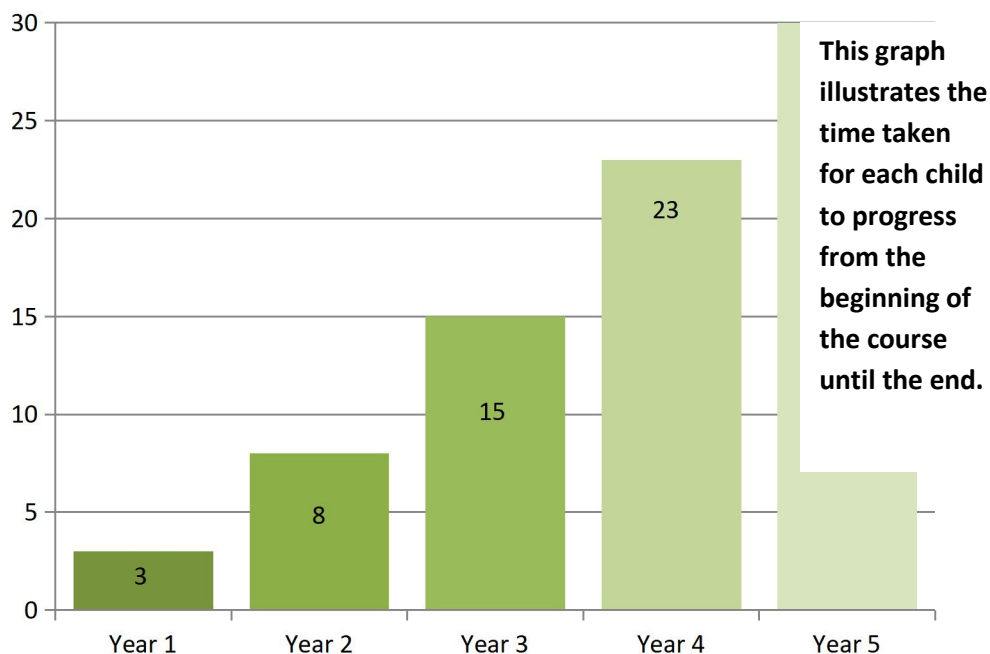

(Number OfJuz)

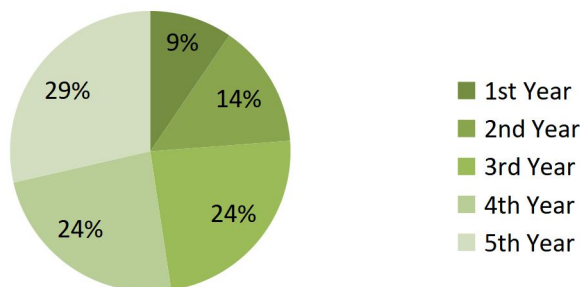


This graph illustrates the time taken for each child to progress from the beginning of the course until the end.

The pie chart represents the amount of Quran memorized by each child over a period of 5yrs as part of the Madrasah Salafiyah Hifz course.

*Madrasah Salafiyah will run the Hifz course weekdays from Mon-Friday.

*The timings will be from 5:00-8:00 daily.

*Additional weekend classes will be provided for students who are having difficulty in keeping up with the syllabus. The cost of this would be £10 per weekend. (excludes the monthly fee)

Cost of Hifz Course

The cost varies each year as the tuition becomes more intensive, enabling teachers to spend quality time and effort on each student.

HIFZ SYLLABUS

Number Of Students

The number of students per class will vary depending on the level the students are at. The following table represents the structure showing the different levels of the hifz course, from the beginning to the end, as well as the amount of students per class.

Number Of Students Per Class

Pre Hifz Class	10-15	Maximum
Class 1	10	Maximum
Class 2	8	Maximum
Class 3	5	Maximum
Class 4	5	Maximum
Class 5	5	Maximum

In this way the amount of learning achieved is maximized, bearing in mind the teacher will not have to teach more than the required amount of students.

The sole aim and purpose of the Hifz program is to give the students the highest quality Hifz education, whereby each student is given complete dedication and focus, ensuring that the student does not under achieve but rather excel in his studies.

Hifz Daily Lesson Plans

Lesson planning is an important element which is needed to ensure that effective learning is taking place, whilst at the same time having an overview of what is already taught and what is to be taught in the future.

All Hifz teachers are given the following lesson plans to follow for their respective years/classes that they will be teaching.

It is extremely important that each teacher adheres and follows the lesson plans as they are designed specifically to ensure that students follow targets set and have clear objectives.

The table above represents the amount of learning that each student is expected to do, depending on which class they are in.

The Teacher **must always listen to the Dars** covered in previous lessons.

This is the reason the '3 back pages' factor is included. This is to be done daily ensuring that the student does not forget the Dars learnt in previous lessons.

HIFZ SYLLABUS

Hifz Students Guidelines

All Hifz students are expected to follow the guidelines which are in place to ensure transparency and clarity, enabling them to understand what is required of them at all times resulting in good overall practice.

- Student must be fluent enough in reading the Qur'an.
- Student must be punctual and not arrive late for lessons.
- Should ensure that he/she is studying to the best of his/her ability.
- Must get his/her progress sheet filled in by the teacher daily.
- Must get his/her progress sheet checked and signed by the parent daily.
- Student must have color coded Quran for the lesson.
- Regular checks will be carried out by the management to ensure such tests are being carried out.
- Must participate in the annual Qur'an competition.
- Must attend the annual exam
- Weekly assembly on Fridays will be a regular feature. For this reason each student must attend it.

The students are reminded that they will be monitored regularly to ensure that the above points are implemented.

Failure to do so will result in Disciplinary action being taken according to the Student Disciplinary Policy 2008.
